20 mph for a calmer environment

Oxton Lib Dems have campaigned for many years to make residential roads safer. Following a proposal by **Allan Brame**, most roads in Oxton will have a 20 mph limit later this year.

Settle doctors' and teachers' strikes

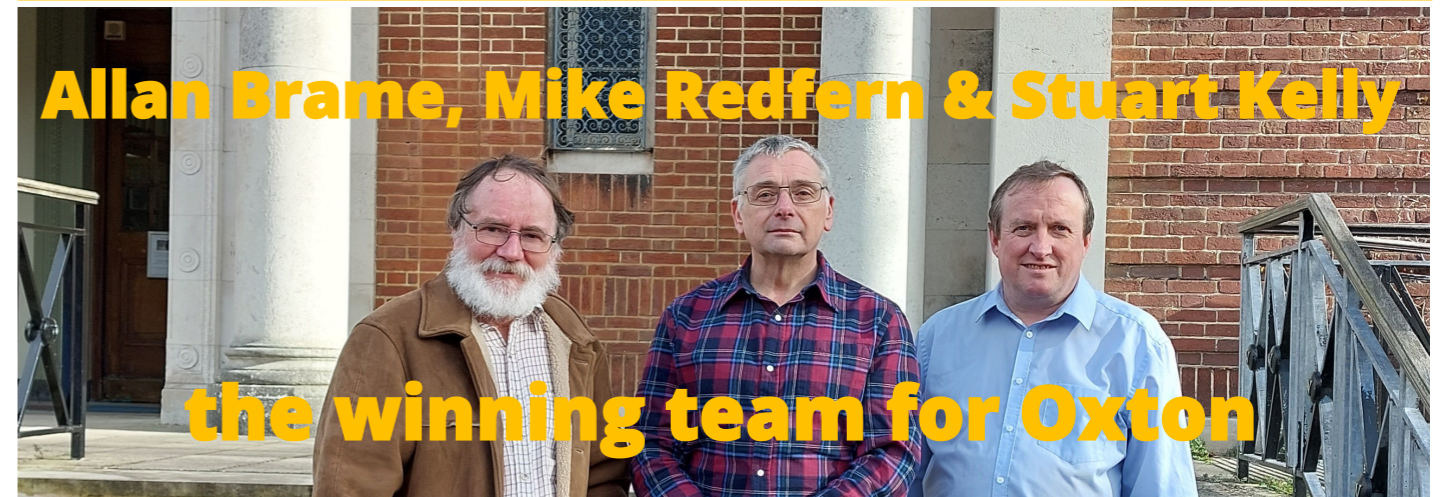
